

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the McGill-Ruth Consolidated Water and Sewer G.I.D. located at 29 Fourth Street, McGill, Nevada 89318, for performing the work as set forth in the Specifications for the MCGILL WELL PUMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT. **The bids will be received on or before 2:00 p.m. local time on October 22, 2025.** The McGill-Ruth Board will consider awarding the contract at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

To assure consideration, all proposals shall be made on the blank form of the proposal attached to these Specifications. The completed forms shall be included in the bound proposal and shall be enclosed and sealed in an envelope which is addressed to McGill-Ruth Consolidated Sewer and Water G.I.D., McGill, Nevada 89318, and marked "McGill Well PUMP REPLACEMENT Project." **Faxed Proposals will not be accepted.**

The Principal items of work for the McGill Well PUMP REPLACEMENT Project will consist of:

- Remove 300 HP vertical line shaft well motor and pump inside building from well;
- Clean and televise well inside building;
- Install submersible pump, motor, and drop pipe in the well inside the building;
- Connect pipe from the well to the piping in the building;
- Rehabilitate electrical service and wiring to operate both wells;

Bidders and other interested parties are encouraged to attend this conference, which will be conducted on **October 8, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.** at the office of McGill-Ruth Consolidated Sewer and Water G.I.D., McGill, Nevada. From there, the meeting will move to the construction site.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive minor irregularities in any bid or in the bidding process. No bidder may withdraw their bid within **thirty (30) days** after the actual date of the opening thereof. Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish both a Payment Bond and Performance Bond in the full amount of the Contract Price for the contract. This project is funded by the State of Nevada Revolving Loan Fund (SRF) and has specific requirements (such as American Iron and Steel) that are unique to this funding. The Bidder is admonished to read and consider the requirements in the bid documents before bidding.
